The SNHEP is a subcommittee of the Equal Employment Opportunity Committee of the Southern Nevada Federal Executive Association. Membership in the council consists of Hispanic Employment Program Managers, as well as representatives from other government sectors and private industry that promulgate and follow organizational policies supporting SNHEP objectives.

The SNHEP was established in the late 1970s to address employment issues relevant to Federal Hispanic employees and Federal contractor employees. Since then the council has expanded its membership to include the private sector, students and anyone interested in making this community more inclusive.

SNHEP's Scholarship Program

In addition to providing an annual regional training conference on current issues, SNHEP uses this venue to provide scholarships to local Hispanic students of any age who wish to further their education. ***Our scholarship program has grown from one \$300 scholarship awarded at our first conference to the awarding of more than 400 scholarships with a dollar value of over \$400,000.***

The scholarship luncheon is always the highlight of the first day of every SNHEP conference. Starting at 11:30 a.m., SNHEP will award approximately thirty \$1,000 scholarships. Scholarship Luncheon tables are available for \$400 or single tickets for \$40.00 per person.
